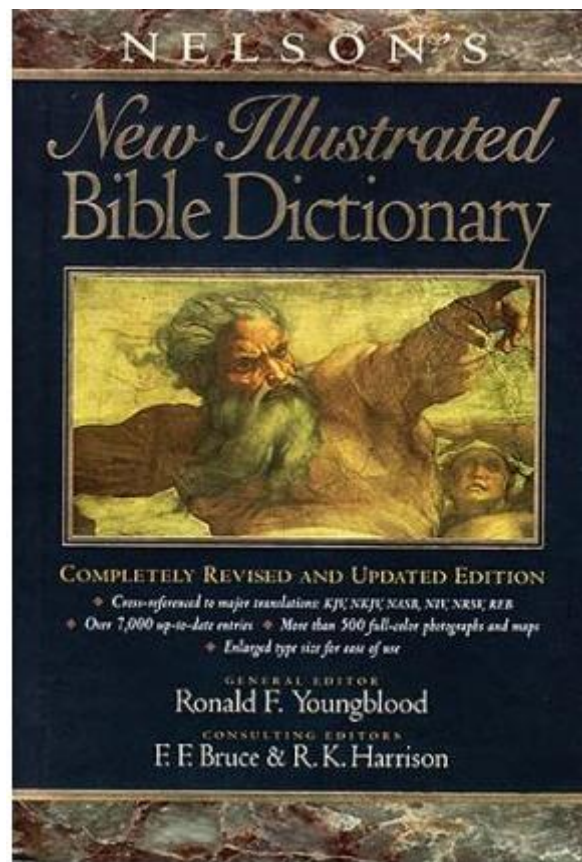

King Asa suppressed the worship **of** Asherah (1 Kin. 15:13), and King Josiah destroyed “the articles that were made for Baal, for Asherah, and for all the host **of** heaven” (2 Kin. 23:4). Recently discovered inscriptions at Kuntillet Ajrud and Khirbet el-Kom seem to indicate that the goddess Asherah was sometimes worshiped as if she were the **wife of** the Lord Himself—a pagan abomination **of** the worst possible sort.

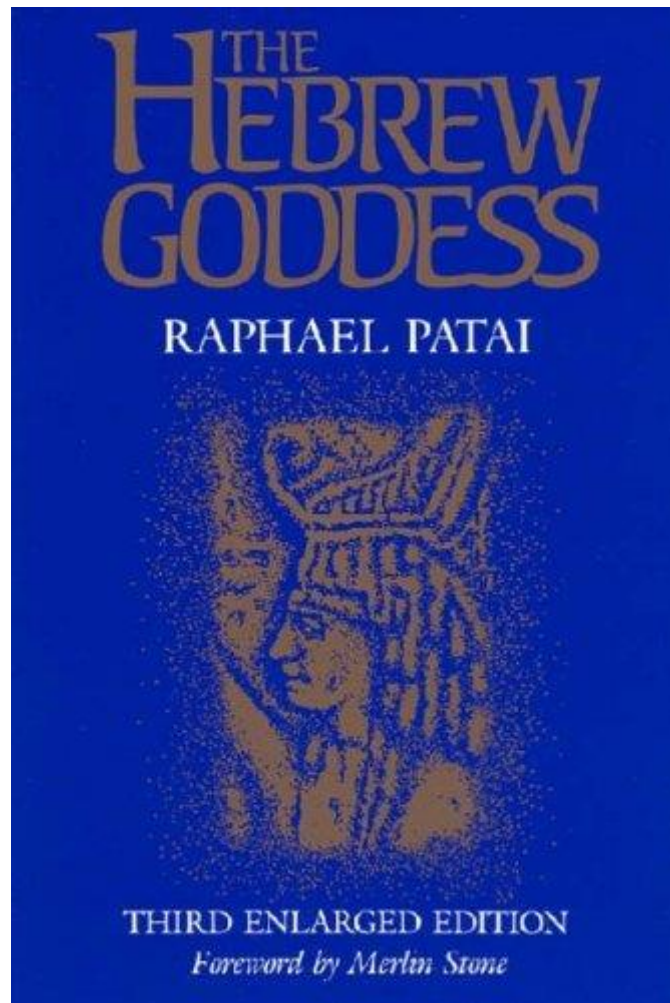

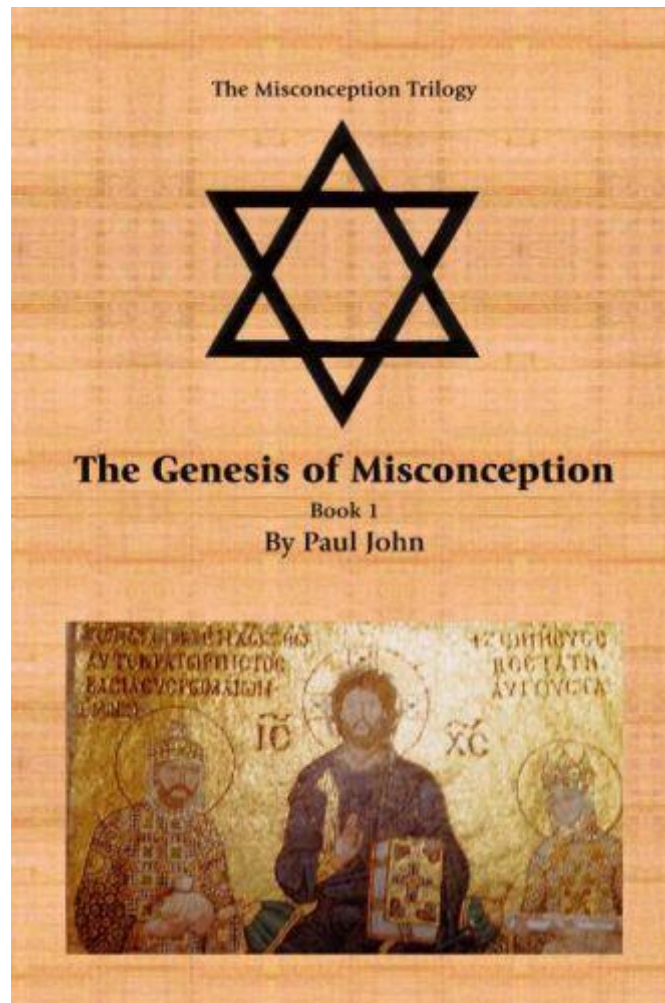

The next most important god was the goddess Athirat or **Asherah**. She was the **consort of El or Yahweh** or both, depending on the age of the myth as well as its origin. In Canaan and the northern areas of Palestine, generally she was El's **consort** or wife. **After many years, Asherah** evolved into Yahweh's **consort** especially in Judah and the southern area. El was made to be the same as **Yahweh** by creative scribes, or they just let the population believe he was the same, or he merged with **Yahweh** as the myths developed. **Asherah** by 1000 BCE became just **asherah**, meaning divine **consort**, **consort of any male**

in both Judah and Israel. The story of these kingdoms, which was likely available to the writer of Malachi, explains why both Judah and Israel were listed as violators of the covenant of the fathers.

1 Kings 15: 9-13

In the twentieth year of Jeroboam king of Israel, Asa began to reign over Judah. And he reigned forty-one years in Jerusalem. And his mother's name was Maacah the daughter of Absalom.

And Asa did that which was right in the eyes of the LORD, like David his father, and he removed the sodomites out of the land, and took away all the idols which his fathers had made .

He even removed his mother Maacah from being queen, because she had made an image of Saraiah. And Asa cut off the heads of the gods. Her image and burned it in the Kidron Valley.

Note : Asherah is the Asherah we referred to previously.

Now therefore send and gather to me all Israel to Mount Carmel, and the four hundred and fifty prophets of Baal, and the four hundred prophets of Asherah , who eat at Jezebel's table.

Note : Baal (meaning Lord) is the deity of the Canaanites, later worshipped by the Hebrews as the same as Jehovah/EL.
